

Non-EU Competent Authorities using DIWASS

Use of DIWASS is voluntary for non-EU¹ competent authorities and non-EU economic operators. Non-EU economic operators may use DIWASS even if their relevant competent authorities do not wish to do so.

This document contains a list of third country authorities using DIWASS, as well as basic information concerning use of DIWASS in such countries.

Section 1 concerns the use of DIWASS. It provides information on:

- Competent authorities of a given country and their scope of competences ,
- Which of these authorities use DIWASS and how (via GUI or an interconnected local system),
- Which of these authorities will be responsible for registration of economic operators in DIWASS,
- Whether operators having a registered office in such country may or are required to use DIWASS for shipments of waste involving an EU Member State (as country of dispatch, transit or destination),
- How such operators may / should access DIWASS (via GUI, interconnected local system or interconnected commercial software).

Section 2 contains information about identification numbers and registration numbers required for registration of operators in DIWASS.

Please note that when registering an operator, the user intending to do so, needs to provide a main identification number². In general, such number for all operators required to have such number under customs legislation should be the EORI number³. However, if operator is not required to have an EORI number, the main identification number shall be another identification number, as provided by the legislation of the country, where this operator is based⁴. This document presents what numbers should be provided in such

situation, as well as any other identification numbers that should be provided by economic operator during the registration.

Please note that DIWASS provides a fixed list of names of identification numbers, that does not include all national names of identification numbers used. Therefore, the users registering the operators when providing registration numbers, need to select a specific label for that, as provided for in this document.

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2025/1290 introduces also the concept of “**site**”. Site means a location of an operator having a different address or name from the address or name indicated by such operator during their first registration in the systems or software, that is allowed under the respective national law to use the same main identification number as the operator concerned⁵. Users registering sites in DIWASS:

- Should not provide a main identification number (as site will be linked with the operator based on the operator’s main identification number),
- Should link the site with the main operator (as provided for in the respective instruction manuals for the DIWASS GUI [link to be provided at later stage]),
- If required by Member States or EEA countries, should provide additional identification numbers or registration numbers. Such requirements are described also in this overview.

Please note that whenever site is concerned by any notification, movement or Annex VII document in DIWASS, the system will display: the contact details of the site as well as the contact details of the main operator.

Please also note that rules presented in this overview are not enforced in DIWASS – it is the responsibility of the user intending to register operators or their sites in DIWASS to select the relevant main identification number or additional identification numbers. The system will not prevent the user from submitting a registration request with incorrect main identification number. The system will only verify if the request for registration of operator indicates a main registration number.

Section 3 contains information on contact points in third countries, to which questions on the use of DIWASS should be addressed to.

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Andorra

1. Access to DIWASS

Andorra has 1 competent authority. This authority is competent for all shipments of waste.

Scope of competence

All types of shipments where the place of dispatch or destination lies within the territory of Andorra including transit.

This authority is also responsible for registration of operators in DIWASS.

How will this authority access DIWASS?

The authority will use DIWASS GUI.

How should operators, having their registered office in its territory, access DIWASS?

All operators should access DIWASS via GUI, if they intend to use DIWASS actively. Use of DIWASS for operators having a registered office in Andorra is voluntary.

2. Identification numbers and registration numbers that should be provided in DIWASS by the operators

Main identification number:

- for economic operators (in case the operator does not have and is not required to have EORI number): Número de Registre Tributari (NRT). When registering in DIWASS, the user should provide its NRT number under the label "Registration number";
- for natural persons not conducting business activity: Not applicable.

Other identification numbers

Even if operator has an EORI number, for purposes of registration it should provide its "Número de Registre Tributari" as additional identification numbers. No other identification numbers are required for registration of operators in Andorra.

For site identification, the private waste manager number will be required, either for the storage facility (EE-xxxx) or the treatment facility (ET-xxxx)

Moldova

1. Access to DIWASS

Moldova has 1 competent authority. This authority is competent for all shipments of waste.

Scope of competence

All types of shipments where the place of dispatch or destination lies within the territory of Moldova including transit.

This authority is also responsible for registration of operators in DIWASS.

How will this authority access DIWASS?

The authority will use DIWASS GUI.

How should operators, having their registered office in its territory, access DIWASS?

All operators should access DIWASS via GUI, if they intend to use DIWASS actively. Use of DIWASS for operators having a registered office in Moldova is voluntary.

All operators can also use commercial software that interconnects directly with DIWASS.

2. Identification numbers and registration numbers that should be provided in DIWASS by the operators

Main identification number:

- for economic operators (in case the operator does not have and is not required to have EORI number): the main identification number of an economic operator is the IDNO (State Identification Number), assigned through the State Register of Legal Entities (RSUD). When registering in DIWASS, the user should provide its IDNO under the label "National Company Number".
- for natural persons not conducting business activity State Identification Number of the individual (IDNP) When registering in DIWASS, the user should provide this information under the label "Registration number (natural person)".

Other identification numbers

Even if operator has an EORI number, for purposes of registration it should provide its [name of number for economic operators] or [name of number for natural person] as additional identification numbers. No other identification numbers are required for registration of operators in Moldova.

No specific identification number for sites is required.

Monaco

1. Access to DIWASS

Monaco has 1 competent authority. This authority is competent for all shipments of waste.

Scope of competence

All types of shipments where the place of dispatch or destination lies within the territory of Monaco including transit.

This authority is also responsible for registration of operators in DIWASS.

How will this authority access DIWASS?

The authority will use DIWASS GUI.

How should operators, having their registered office in its territory, access DIWASS?

All operators should access DIWASS via GUI. Use of DIWASS for operators having a registered office in Monaco is obligatory.

All operators can also use commercial software that interconnects directly with DIWASS.

2. Identification numbers and registration numbers that should be provided in DIWASS by the operators

Main identification number:

- for economic operators (in case the operator does not have and is not required to have EORI number): **Répertoire du Commerce et de l'Industrie (RCI - <https://teleservice.gouv.mc/rci/>)**. When registering in DIWASS, the user should provide its RCI number under the label "National Company Number";
- for natural persons not conducting business activity: **[missing]**

Other identification numbers

Even if operator has an EORI number, for purposes of registration it should provide its Répertoire du Commerce et de l'Industrie (RCI) as additional identification numbers. No other identification numbers are required for registration of operators based in Monaco.

No specific identification number for sites is required.

All types of shipments where the place of dispatch or destination lies within the territory of North Macedonia including transit.

This authority is also responsible for registration of operators in DIWASS.

How will this authority access DIWASS?

The authority will use DIWASS GUI.

How should operators, having their registered office in its territory, access DIWASS?

All operators should access DIWASS via GUI, if they intend to use DIWASS actively. Use of DIWASS for operators having a registered office in North Macedonia is voluntary.

All operators can also use commercial software that interconnects directly with DIWASS.

2. Identification numbers and registration numbers that should be provided in DIWASS by the operators

Main identification number:

- for economic operators (in case the operator does not have and is not required to have EORI number): **Central Business Register**. When registering in DIWASS, the user should provide its VAT number under the label "Central Business Register";
- for natural persons not conducting business activity: **Registration number**. When registering in DIWASS, the user should provide this information under the label "Registration number (natural person)".

Other identification numbers

Even if operator has an EORI number, for purposes of registration it should provide its [name of number for economic operators] or [name of number for natural person] as additional identification numbers. No other identification numbers are required for registration of operators in North Macedonia.

No specific identification number for sites is required.

San Marino has 1 competent authority. This authority is competent for all shipments of waste.

Scope of competence

All types of shipments where the place of dispatch or destination lies within the territory of San Marino including transit.

This authority is also responsible for registration of operators in DIWASS.

How will this authority access DIWASS?

The authority will use DIWASS GUI.

How should operators, having their registered office in its territory, access DIWASS?

All operators should access DIWASS via GUI, if they intend to use DIWASS actively. Use of DIWASS for operators having a registered office in San Marino is voluntary.

All operators can also use commercial software that interconnects directly with DIWASS.

2. Identification numbers and registration numbers that should be provided in DIWASS by the operators

Main identification number:

- for economic operators (in case the operator does not have and is not required to have EORI number): **Codice Operatore Economico (COE)**. When registering in DIWASS, the user should provide its COE number under the label “National Company Number”;
- for natural persons not conducting business activity: **Codice ISS**. When registering in DIWASS, the user should provide this information under the label “Registration number (natural person)”.

Other identification numbers

Even if operator has an EORI number, for purposes of registration it should provide its Codice Operatore Economico or Codice ISS as additional identification numbers. No other identification numbers are required for registration of San Marino operators.

No specific identification number for sites is required.
